philanthropic programs Operation School Bell, opens its "store" every fall and outfits students from

36 schools with new shoes, two pairs of pants, three shirts, socks, underwear, belt and jacket. What started with 101 students in 1999 grew to over 2,105 in 2014-2015.

() Trauma Care/Domestic Violence. Members pack sweatsuits, underwear, socks and hygiene kits for victims of domestic violence and sexual assault whose clothes are often taken as evidence. The kits, delivered to 15 hospitals and six shelters, are a first step to recovery.

New Beginnings. Starting a stable life after abuse and leaving a shelter is scary, especially with children. We delivered 276 kits to 133 women and 143 children with pots and pans, cleaning products, dishes, linens, cutlery, books and toys to help make that transition gentler.

Gen-1 Scholars. To help students who are the first in their families to go to college, ALGC has partnered with a cutting-edge plan at the University of Cincinnati to provide two scholarships.

College Starter Kits. Basics, including a flash drive, notebooks and other school supplies worth \$4,563 were provided to 251 financially-challenged adult students struggling to pay for college at four local universities.



ALGC'S impact the numbers

Women and children affected by domestic violence who were helped through New

Beginnings kits containing pots and pans,

cleaning supplies, utensils, dishes, linens as they move from shelters to new homes. Value \$25,431.

The value of a donated hour* by members and community volunteers like Wally Lynch (with his mom) working to make our programs successful. For his

birthday, he invited friends to bring toys for children transitioning from shelter life to a new home in our New Beginnings kits.

Hours worked by 76 tireless volunteers from community groups, including church members. businesses and student-athletes. Value \$24,237.

Children from 36 Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky schools who visited our Operation School

Bell "shop" this year were outfitted with pants, shirts, shoes, underwear, socks, belt and a fleece jacket. Value, \$139.455.

Victims of abuse and domestic violence we reached out to with clothes and emergency supplies as they coped with survival. Value, \$22,599.

Housing scholarships of \$1,500 each were given to two Gen-1 students at the University of Cincinnati. Value, \$3,000.

Financially disadvantaged adult college students at four local universities received kits with flash drives, notebooks and school supplies to help trim the high cost of college. Value, \$4,604.



Total volunteer hours worked by ALGC members to make a lasting impact of change in our community. Value \$299,217.


